UNIT-e supports all Scottish Further Education Funding Council statutory returns in line with the Further Education Statistics (FES) requirements. UNIT-e also supports the Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA) requirements including the XML standards. Additional modules are also available to support the Bursary and Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) schemes and Student Loan Company (SLC) file transactions.

Features

- UNIT-e supports all FES returns including; FES1 Programme data, FES2 Student data and FES3 Student Programme Element data. UNIT-e will also produce the SARU Performance Indicator
- UNIT-e provides SQA data transfers in XML format which enable Registration, Entry and Unit Result transmissions to be made
- UNIT-e provides the ability to load SQA approval files ensuring accurate curriculum data set-up
- UNIT-e provides flexible data entry screens (Information Interfaces) enabling colleges to define data capture layouts
- UNIT-e provides facilities to update data rapidly. Grid-edit tools enable fast error correction whilst warehouse routines enable regular data inconsistency checks and automatic rectification processes to be implemented

- The **UNIT-e Student Funds System** provides solutions for the management of bursaries and hardship funds and produces BACS payment files
- **EMA Management;** UNIT-e provides a module to support the management of the national Educational Maintenance Allowance payments
- **Student Loan Company transactions;** UNIT-e provides the ability to process the SLC support status file and submit the attendance notification file required to initiate loan payments
