



UNIT-e Tools for SharePoint

UNIT-e and Microsoft SharePoint 2007 provide an integrated suite of browser-based tools for enterprise search, content management, business process management and simplified information sharing.

There are already numerous ways to expose UNIT-e data; Crystal Reports, the Office Builder Products, Internet Builder or even CSV exports. Whilst each tool is very useful in its own right it would be nice to be able to draw on the best elements of each and present the result in a single location accessible to all.

Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007 is an integrated suite of server capabilities that can help improve organisational effectiveness by providing comprehensive content management and facilitating information-sharing across boundaries. With UNIT-e Tools for SharePoint you can embed UNIT-e data and functionality right in the heart of SharePoint, taking advantage of the facilities to publish and control access.

Wouldn't it be nice to see your timetable or events data stored in UNIT-e in your MS Outlook calendar? Or perhaps you want students to see their exams timetables online? With UNIT-e Tools for SharePoint you can tie data in UNIT-e to lists such as calendars in SharePoint. In fact you can (optionally) even update events in UNIT-e to reflect changes made in SharePoint.

UNIT-e can also take advantage of SharePoint's strong file storage and indexing functionality to store indexed hot linked documents, student photos, references etc and expose for search and retrieval via the Internet. Tight integration with Microsoft Office means files are stored against the desired record, without the problems of version control associated with file shares and with the added advantage of the histories, check-out/in features.

When combined with UNIT-e Workflow, UNIT-e Tools for Excel and UNIT-e Tools for Reporting Services, the argument becomes even more compelling.
